All STA applicants must complete the prescribed review process (including renewals and legal non-conforming uses)

Pre-Screening Meeting (prior to submission of STA application)

1. Submit a completed "Request for STA Pre-Screening Meeting" to Planning Services – planning@thebluemountains.ca
2. A meeting will be scheduled within 10 days
3. Basic information regarding the proposed Short Term Accommodation use must be provided (including the zoning of the property, a concept site plan, property address, number of bedrooms, expected occupant load, number/location of parking spaces, etc.)
4. Following the meeting, the applicant will receive confirmation from Planning Services and/or the STA Coordinator of the necessary steps required to obtain an STA licence. Any required approvals will be identified, including application requirements, associated fees, and additional supporting information that may be necessary

STA Licence Application Form

- Complete the "Application for a Short Term Accommodation (STA) Licence" form

Floor Plan

Floor plans of the STA premises **drawn to scale** depicting the:

- Proposed use of each room and it's dimensions
- Location of all smoke alarms
- Location of all fire extinguishers
- Location of all exits
- Location of all windows (dimensions are required)

Supporting Documentation

- A copy of the Transfer/Deed proving evidence of ownership
- A copy of the Liability Insurance of not less than \$2 million per occurrence for property damage and bodily injury
- Property Management Plan (non-condo units only)

- Certificate from the Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) that the premises conforms to the Ontario Electrical Code
- Renters Code
- Fire Safety Plan
- Fuel Burning Appliances Inspection Reports
- Responsible Person Consent form

Required Fees & Charges (including HST)

- STA Licensing Fee – Type A: \$2,200.00 (two year term)
- STA Licensing Fee – Type B: \$2,200.00 (two year term)
- STA Licensing Fee – Type C: \$2,250.00 (two year term)
- STA Licensing Fee – Type D: \$1,075.00 (two year term)
- Fire Safety Inspection Fee: \$75.00
- Fire Safety Re-inspection Fee: \$125.00
- Subsequent Fire Safety Re-inspection Fee: \$175.00
- Tribunal Fee: \$600.00
- Appeal Tribunal Decision to Council Fee: \$400.00

Incomplete STA Licence applications will delay processing time. Where an application is determined **not** to satisfy the requirements of the STA Licensing By-law (2021-71), the Municipal Licensing Officer, Enforcement Services may refuse the application/licence.
